SUBJECT: Addendum No. 1 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) for Bulk Material Collection for Baltimore County, Maryland, dated September 2, 2021.

This Addendum No. 1 is to issue amendments to the RFP and answer Proposer questions submitted in writing by the question submittal due date of September 30, 2021. Answers issued by written addenda will be binding on the Authority, including the answers provided below.

Per Section 1 of the RFP, the following language:

“The County and Authority at their discretion shall decide which of the above methods of Service (either Service Area Bulk Material Collection or Special Collection) will be performed out of this RFP, either one or the other will be selected – not both. The Special Collection method will be used by the County only as requested by the County for special circumstances (there is no guarantee of usage by the County or Authority for this Service).”

shall be amended and replaced with the following language:

“The County and Authority at their discretion shall decide which of the above methods of Service (either Service Area Bulk Material Collection or Special Collection) will be performed out of this RFP, with both methods available to be selected as options by the County and Authority during the term of the Service Contract. The Special Collection method will be used only as requested by the County and Authority for special circumstances (there is no guarantee of usage by the County or Authority for this Service).”

- 1. Question:** Is there a list of companies you could please share, as [Proposer name removed] is an **MBE/DBE** certified supplier? It is our strong belief [Proposer name removed] can help save money on trash trucks and also help satisfy **MBE** goals.

Answer: The Authority is providing, as Attachment A, the Vendor List used to solicit the RFP to potential Proposers. This should not be viewed as an endorsement of any of the firms in particular and is only provided for informational purposes.

- 2. Question:** Is it possible to only bid on 2.1.2 Special Collection and not 2.1.1?

Answer: Per Appendix C, Cost Proposal Form C-1, and Section 2.1 of Appendix A, Service Contract, the Proposer must submit Price Proposals for BOTH Service Area Bulk Material Collection Services AND Special Collection Services, to be considered under this RFP.

- 3. Question:** Currently Baltimore County does not offer Bulk Trash/Debris pick-up? True or False

Answer: True. Currently, Baltimore County does not offer bulk material collections, including bulk trash or bulk reuse/recycling collections.

- 4. Question:** Why is Baltimore County now looking to offer Bulk Debris pick-up to its residents?

Answer: Per the Baltimore County Solid Waste Work Group, created by County Executive Johnny Olszewski in October 2020 (more information located here: [https://www.baltimorecountymd.gov/boards-commissions/executive/solid-waste-work-group?ct=t\(Baltimore County News Media Advisory 2013 29 2016\)](https://www.baltimorecountymd.gov/boards-commissions/executive/solid-waste-work-group?ct=t(Baltimore%20County%20News%20Media%20Advisory%202013%2029%202016))), and per the Final Report of the Baltimore County Solid Waste Work Group, dated June 17, 2021 (located here: [https://resources.baltimorecountymd.gov/Documents/Executive/solidwasteworkgroup/Final%20ReportBCGSolidWasteWorkGroupWOAppendices.pdf?ct=t\(Baltimore County News Media Advisory 2013 29 2016\)](https://resources.baltimorecountymd.gov/Documents/Executive/solidwasteworkgroup/Final%20ReportBCGSolidWasteWorkGroupWOAppendices.pdf?ct=t(Baltimore%20County%20News%20Media%20Advisory%202013%2029%202016))), recommendations for new County services and programs included bulk item collection services with reuse/donation/recycling options.

- 5. Question:** Why was the decision made to request a per day fee to cover a daily expectation of 957 residents rather than a per pick-up fee?

Answer: Annual residential trash collection for four types of pick up for the 335,999 units in Baltimore County is paid in the same way.

- 6. Question:** Is the current budget \$255k minus \$48k for a supervisor = \$205k for the annual budget of roughly less than \$800 (\$0.82 per residence) a day to cover all 957 residents daily?

Answer: The above budgeted amount, per the above referenced Final Report of the Baltimore County Solid Waste Work Group, dated June 17, 2021, reflects a planning number for the development of the Bulk Material Collection program and not the costs for the actual collections. The Proposer is to submit a Proposal based upon their cost to provide the Services as described in the RFP.

- 7. Question:** For Bulk Materials: Of the 957 households serviced daily – how many households utilized the service on average daily in the last 12-months?

Answer: Baltimore County has not provided bulk material collections, including bulk trash or bulk reuse/recycling collections, in the last 12 months.

- 8. Question:** For Bulk Materials: Would households schedule services with the Agency who in turn would notify the Contractor of a needed pick-up within the zone and then be scheduled to be picked up at the next zone route OR is the expectation that the approved vendor drives a daily route collecting any materials found along the route?

Answer: The awarded Contractor would drive a daily route collecting up to three Bulk Materials per residential unit along the route, as long as they are properly set out by the resident and fall under the Acceptable Materials definition. If more than three Bulk Materials are set out per residential unit, the Contractor will take the three largest qualifying Bulk Materials by volume (not by weight).

- 9. Question:** For Bulk Materials: Is there a geographic map or zone list available for review or is that at the discretion of the Contractor?

Answer: The County will provide the awarded Contractor a route (a geographic map/zone and list of qualifying residences) to be serviced under the Service Contract.

- 10. Question:** For Special Collections: on average how many “Special Collections” were performed in the past year?

Answer: The County has an in-house workforce that performs “Special Collections” of many and diverse kinds; however, the number of Special Collections has not been tallied by the County. This workforce sometimes, during peak demand, cannot handle all of the work asked of it. Special Collection, as described in the RFP, is meant to provide relief for those times when the in-house workforce has more work than it can perform. There is no guarantee of work for the Proposer under Special Collection.

- 11. Question:** For Special Collections: Any available information on average weight of each tipping performed?

Answer: No, there is no available information.

- 12. Question:** Is it the intent of the requestor “County Bureau of Solid Waste” to group Special collections in zones?

Answer: No. The County will schedule Services with the Contractor by an on-call request for each needed Special Collections pick-up, to be performed by the Contractor within one week of the request (see Section 2.1.2 of the Service Contract). The Contractor is allowed to schedule and perform this pick-up at its convenience within the window of one week, in order to more efficiently coordinate its own collections. There is no guarantee of usage by the County or Authority for this Service.

- 12.a. Question:** If so – would multiple pick-ups be expected prior to tipping the materials at the acceptance facility?

Answer: No. The Contractor is allowed to coordinate, schedule, conduct collections and tip the Acceptable Material at its convenience, within the one-week window of time from the on-call request by the County. Please note, this Special Collection Service would not be allowed to be combined with the Service Area Bulk Material Collection Service, since the time and routes are billed separately (i.e., the collection truck cannot combine Acceptable Materials from each Service or perform the Special Collection during a dedicated Service Area Bulk Material Collection route).

- 13. Question:** Is it the expectation of the requestor that each pick-up regardless of size/weight be immediately moved to a tipping facility?

Answer: For both Services, the Contractor would be required to tip once its collection truck is full, as applicable.

- 14. Question:** If that is the case would the requestor expect all pick-ups happen Mon-Friday 7am – 4pm (allowing time to transport to the facility before closing)?

Answer: The Contractor shall utilize the Acceptance Facilities during their hours of operation. See the following:

Central Acceptance Facility (“CAF”), 10275 Beaver Dam Road, Cockeysville, MD 21030: Open from 7:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

*Eastern Sanitary Landfill (“ESL”), 6259 Days Cove Road, White Marsh, MD 21162:
Open from 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday.*

*Western Acceptance Facility (“WAF”), 3310 Transway Road, Halethorpe, MD 21227:
Open from 7:00 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday.*

- 15. Question:** Will there be an opportunity to bid solely on the Special Collections without bidding on the Bi-weekly Bulk Material collection?

Answer: No. Please see the answer to Question #2 above.
