Northeast Maryland Waste Disposal Authority is providing the Department of the Environment with this annual compliance report relative to the requirements of 40 CFR Part 63 Subpart ZZZZ (National Emissions Standard for Hazardous Air Pollutants for Stationary Reciprocating Internal Combustion Engines).

Two (2) stationary spark-ignited (SI) reciprocating internal combustion engines (RICE) are operated at its landfill gas-fueled electricity generation facility located at 389 Burns Crossing Road, Severn, MD 21144. Table IV-1B of Part 70 Operating Permit No. 24-003-01471 requires the submittal of an annual report as specified in the RICE NESHAP and must contain the information specified in 40CFR §63.6650(g)(1) through (g)(3).

The Attachment provides a certified annual compliance report for the RICE NESHAP for the reporting period January 1 through December 31, 2020.
